If you want to mix your fabrics and the kit—I cannot “split” the kit, so you would have to purchase the entire kit, but the price will be reasonable!

\*\*Please try to print or have loaded onto a tablet, the instructions for the project

**\*\*The complete list of materials, cutting instructions etc are in that file if you plan to use your own fabric choices—please use that as a guide**

--Embroidery Machine with Embroidery Unit and Embroidery Foot

--Power cord

--Hoops—6” X 10” and 5” X 7”

--Embroidery needles—I like 90/14 or topstitch but bring what you like

--Batting, Embroidery Batting or Battilizer

--SF101 for backgrounds

--Heat ‘n Bond Light –not required but it helps your designs to lay flat

--Ruler and Rotary Cutter

--Threads—bobbin thread on bobbins and colors of choice (see photo)

\*\*I used poly embroidery threads for all

--Stabilizer—Power/No-show Mesh

\*\*If pre-quilting the blocks (“Block by Block” on the file)

the stabilizer and batting will be

included in the stitching before the “design”

*\*\*Since this is a Sunday class beginning at 12:00 and going until 5:00—if you want to bring a snack or food to share that is great—nothing too “messy” !!*
