

BUILD YOUR WARDROBE: KNIT JACKET--Supply List

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RICHLAND SEWING CENTER

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This class is part of the new “Build Your Wardrobe” program offered by Richland Sewing Center. This program has classes on making a jacket, pants, a straight skirt and a top all from knit fabric.

You will construct the jacket using McCall’s pattern M7331. This is an easy pattern with excellent instructions written by Nancy Zieman.

Supplies you need to bring:

1. Pattern: McCalls M7331

If your full bust measurement is 38” or more, buy the larger size group.

Do not buy the pattern based on your Ready to Wear dress size

2. Fabric: This pattern is for knits only. Select a medium weight moderate stretch knit. A good ponte knit or double knit works well. Look on pattern envelope for yardage needed for the selected garment. If you plan to make coordinating pieces, buy additional yardage.
3. Sewing machine, power cord, foot pedal. Sewing feet.
4. Stretch or jersey sewing machine needles
5. Sharp pins! Or pattern weights.
6. Fabric shears
7. Fabric marking pen or tracing wheel and paper.
8. Tape measure
9. Seam gauge
10. Seam ripper
11. Coordinating color of sewing thread. (Rayon or polyester embroidery thread is not suitable.)
12. Bias fusible tape OR lightweight fusible interfacing cut into 1” bias strips.
