

SERGER CHRISTMAS

Supply List

In this class you will stitch several types of “stitches” with different techniques to help you know what you can do to have fun with your machine. We hope that you have some basic knowledge of your serger about threading and settings, but we will do our best to help you along. We will use the rolled hem, gathering, 3 thread wide overlock and 4 thread overlock.

Bring: Serger with power cord and foot control
Tweezers and screwdriver for needles
1 spool each of Sulky 30# or 12# cotton in red and green
4 cones red serger thread (Maxi Lock preferred)
Washable marker or Frixion
Ruler and rotary cutter if available

For tree napkin: 2 fat quarters of reds and/or greens- contrasting but no directional fabrics

For Ruffle Towel: $\frac{3}{4}$ yard towel fabric (available here) OR hand or fingertip towel
1/8 yard ruffle fabric
2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " X Width of fabric strip for band
Rick-rack to match

Lined Zipper Bag—Put in a zipper with your serger. We will “weave” fabric strips with serged edges done with Decora decorative thread. There will be a kit for this project for the fabrics and zipper provided at low cost payable at class.

We may add some things that are not listed here if time allows!
