

Anita Goodesign Hoop Clocks

Supply List

****Pattern: Anita Goodesign Hoop Clock** . This pattern requires a hoop size 8 x 8 or larger.

After you get your pattern, choose the clock you want to make.

This pattern will show 3 Techniques. The Applique Technique will be the quickest to make. The Folded fabric technique second. The Radial Technique will take the longest and most fabric.

****Design is available at RSC. *If you have all access, you have the design in the August month book.***

Fabric: Fat quarters, scraps of the colors you wish, check your pattern for size.

Your base (background) go a bit bigger use a 10 x 10

There are several clocks that require more scrap fabric. Be sure to bring the additional fabric. Be warned that those clocks will take a bit longer to complete.

Thread to match.

Tear away stabilizer

7" wooden embroidery hoop. (I couldn't find any wooden one so I used a plastic one). .

Clock Kit, they can be purchased at Hobby Lobby, Michaels, and Joann's. You want to get the small kit with the black hands. Battery for clock.

Embroidery machine, power cord, HOOP (8 x 8 or larger), power cord, and foot pedal. Sewing machine accessories, scissors, marking pen, rotary cutter, ruler, Circular ruler, tape, embroidery needle 75/11, and hot glue gun Fabric marker or chalk and Spray fabric adhesive, any snacks you want to share.

In the wood section, look for a pkg of 7" circles of wood. I used one to stabilize my clock. I will provide a drill to cut the hole in the center. This is an add-on to the pattern supply list. ++++Optional++++
