

CHRISTMAS APPLIQUE BENCH PILLOW SUPPLY LIST

This is a great addition to your Christmas decorations, and can be completed as a bench pillow or a table runner. It is basic machine appliqué and easy to do.

If you have a Scan 'N Cut you can cut the letters on that--I have the papers for you to scan here. If not, bring your fabrics prepared with fusible web (most letters are within 9" X 5"--the "M" is larger), such as Heat & Bond Lite--or have them ready to fuse, I can help you cut them here on my cutter.

Bring: Pattern "**A Year in Words CHRISTMAS**"--25% off for class

- Fabrics for each letter
- Background--1/2 yard (shown black)
- Fusible Web
- Sewing machine with power cord and foot control
- Open toe foot if available
- Lightweight bobbin thread on bobbin (pre-filled is great)
- Embroidery threads or cotton threads for letters to match or accent the letters
- Scissors and basic sewing supplies
- 1 yard Totally Stable fusible stabilizer

**Depending on how you plan to finish your project, you will need backing fabric and possibly batting or a pillow form.

**If you have not done much appliqué, this is an easy pattern to use and we will help you with some practice stitching once your letters and designs are cut and fused.
