## **Reading Pillow**

## Supplies:

Embroidery design of your choice. Found on the following sites: Designs by JUJU; mypetitefleurdesigns.com; Oh My Crafty Supplies; Applique Corner; Anita Goodesigns; (search Reading Pillow designs on Etsy, etc). Download your design to a USB stick in your machine's format.

1 yd. fabric\* for pillow front and back of pillow, cut into 3 pieces 18" x 18"

12" x 18" piece of fabric for front of pocket (I pre-quilted the front of the pocket, if you want to do that you will use the batting and a piece of muslin for this)

12" x 18" piece of **batting\*** (I used Battilizer\*)

12" x 18" piece of fabric for pillow pocket cuff and back of pocket

Mesh Cut Away Stabilizer\*

**Shape Flex AKA SF 101\***, fused to fabric you are using for the front of pocket front to support your embroidery design

**Terial Magic\*** or "Jeannie" mix" to prep embroidery fabric

22" zipper (not metal) \*

Wonder tape\*, 1/4"

Thread\* to match embroidery design

Embroidery bobbins\* (2)

Embroidery needle 90/14\* (2)

Pillow form 18" x 18"

Embroidery Machine, power cord, embroidery arm, embroidery foot\*

**Embroidery hoop\*** to accommodate your chosen embroidery design

Adhesive Spray\*

**General sewing notions\***: scissors, rotary cutter, pins, small ruler, etc.

The embroidery will take the majority of the class. This is a wonderful project that can be used for a birth announcement, anniversary gift or for any occasion you want to preserve for a special memory. Please call me with any questions, Deborah, 817-925-8756.
