Supply List:

Winter Mug Rugs by Amelie Scott*

Embroidery Machine with power cord*

Embroidery Unit With Embroidery Foot*

USB stick* with designs downloaded in your machine's format

6x10" Embroidery Hoop*

Embroidery Needles 90/14*

Embroidery Bobbins x 2*

Mesh Cut Away Stabilizer*

White Top Cover (OESD)* or Color Keep Topping (Floriani)* (Jeannie has this)

Embroidery Thread* (to coordinate with color of fabric you choose)

Fabric* as follows:

2 strips of same fabric 2x6"

1 strip of accent fabric 2x6"

6x6" Background Fabric

2 pieces 6x10" for envelope back

Scraps for applique (at least 4x4")

Insul- Bright* batting 5 3/8" x 7 7/8" (I use Insul- Bright in my mug rugs, you may wish to use regular batting)

Steam-A-Seam 1/4" strip*

Adhesive Spray*(KK)

SF101* or fusible Interfacing*

Sewing Notions*: applique scissors, seam ripper, ruler, rotary cutter, etc.

I customized these mug rugs to give them more “POP”. The pattern is designed for binding. Instead we will do an envelope back. I also added background quilting to the project.
