

SNOWMAN PILLOW OR WALL HANGING

Christmas Club Sewing—January 2022

Supply List

I just love this project—and I hope you will too. I have “edited” the directions some to save time and make it a bit easier, but you can choose to do it as the pattern reads also.

Bring: Sewing machine with power cord and foot control

-1/4" foot or setting

-Walking/Dual feed foot for quilting

-24" piece of fleece, batting or Soft and Stable

-24" square of muslin or light colored cotton (will not be seen)

**for Pillow: 20" or 18" pillow form (can do this after class)

2/3 yard of backing fabric

22" zipper

**for Wall Hanging: 2/3 yard backing fabric

fabric for tabs if desired

-24" Ruler and Rotary Cutter

-Washable or Iron off marker

-Scissors and basic supplies—pins and basting spray

-Thread and bobbin for piecing and quilting

**Fabrics for front: Charm pack plus $\frac{1}{4}$ yard co-ordinating for edges

OR—2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips of fabric to cut for borders (at least 6)

**you can cut 32 $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares ahead

***IF you can choose 10 of your charm squares ahead of class

that would save time. If you want to cut those into

squares ($2\frac{1}{2}$ ") ahead that is great -it takes 32 squares

The original pattern uses 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares for double borders—I chose

to use a single row of squares and add a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " fabric border outside

**2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strip to cover zipper for pillow

My sample is Christmas colors, but it would also look great in blues or grays or anything you choose. Snowmen are good all year long!!

If you want to “color” some I have a good supply of water color pencils you can use
