

Street Smart Quilted Table Runner

Supply List:

This is a fun Table Runner to make! Supplies: Pattern on order--at RSC
All of the supplies you will need for this class are available at Richland Sewing Center.

--For the backing and sashing you need 4 different pieces: Assorted ½ yd. pieces (One extra piece may be needed in case of cutting or sewing errors. Directional prints may not be suitable.)

--Thread that will match or blend with backing fabric.

--Batting: Low-loft cotton batting. Choose a brand that is stable, not stretchy, and does not distort when pressed. Polyester batting is not recommended.

--Template Plastic: 7" square

--Fun & Done Batting Buddy Template Set. They are optional, but work really well when cutting fabric and batting.

--The backing becomes the binding.

For the one I made (which is hanging in the store) I used 2 different fabrics for the backing and the quilting pieces on the front. You may make each square a different fabric or narrow it down to two or three different fabrics.

--Ruler and Rotary Cutter

--Sewing machine with power cord and foot control
