## EMBROIDERED PANTS Supply List

I have had a lot of fun adding embroidery to garments for years, and this last fall I got super inspired to add to jeans or pants due to seeing (and pricing) some garments for sale in stores. I felt super special wearing my creations--and hope you will have fun with this technique.

Due to class time restrictions, we will stitch a more "simple"--low stitch count design onto your garment. We will open seams where necessary (you can do that at home if you want)--talk about template placement--and then stitch. I have a nice selection of designs that work well on pants that you can choose from-and you can stop by before class time to look those over if you want. If you have a design that you want to use, bring that but make sure that it is not too stitch intense.

Bring: Pants, jeans, jacket or whatever you would like to stitch on--\*\*you might want to use a "practice" garment, or pants/jeans that you don't consider "designer" material and save your great garments for stitching later with bigger designs.

- -Embroidery machine with power cord and embroidery foot
- -Larger hoops (5 X 7 is minimum)
- -USB for designs
- -Tear Away stabilizer
- -Water soluble topping
- -basting spray
- -Thread assortment
- -Bobbin (I prefer dark thread for this if pants are dark but white is OK)
- -Seam ripper and small scissors
