Supply List

The Design Center project for this session is a placemat/table mat/wall mat—you choose! It features a layered applique star with stitch adjustments and variety, a “fill” background with placement positioning adjustments, saving your design in “layers”, and then adding borders and backing to finish it out. You will have a step-by-step handout to go along in class as you create—it’s fun!!!

Dream machines and Stellaires will not have all “adjustments” but will do fine!

Bring: Brother embroidery machine with Design Center feature

Embroidery unit, power cord and embroidery foot

-Design Center stylus or mouse

-Hoop—9 ½” X 14 or larger –magnetic hoop not recommended for this

-Sewing foot (Muv-it)

-Scissors, ruler, rotary cutter and marker

-USB for saving

Fabrics: 18” X 24” Background piece—*I will provide a lite fusible batting* (shown white stars)

-Cotton batting 18” x 24”

-8” fabric square for outer applique frame shape (shown navy)

-6” fabric square for star--backed with SF101 (shown red)

Finishing fabrics: 2/3 yard for borders and backing (shown navy star print)

Threads—your choice for background quilting (shown red)

-Applique threads in navy (shown outside navy square)

-Red-(shown candlewicking)

-White/ecru/metallic—around star

-Monofilament for ditch around borders

-Lightweight bobbin thread (pre-filled is fine)

-Bobbin to match backing fabric
