

QUILT BLOCKS TRIM AND JOIN

Supply List

This class is all about putting quilt blocks together before they are quilted--or some can apply to quilted blocks, too, such as embroidered blocks. Once you are ready to “assemble” a pieced, appliquéd or embroidered quilt you need to trim the blocks (according to the method you will use to join them), add sashing (if chosen) and make sure that everything lines up, and be ready to layer. If you have quilted blocks to join--there are several ways to do that and we will learn those at this class.

Bring: Sewing machine with power cord and foot control

- 1/4” foot
- standard foot
- walking (even feed) foot if available
- Neutral thread (cotton preferred but not required)
- ruler and rotary cutter--24” ruler and 9 to 12 ½” square if possible
- 1/4 yard of fabric to play with

Fabrics and batting for the blocks will be provided in class unless you have some ready that you would like to use. In class we will stitch “practice” blocks to learn on. The fabric that you bring as listed above will be used for practice sashings and joining strips. Call with any questions--
