

APPLIQUE PROJECT

Supply List

This applique project is a "bunny"—ready for Easter and spring! The pieces for applique will be pre-cut in a kit for you. You will need to purchase the pattern for class from the store, and it includes instructions for a table runner as well as the small hanging as shown in the photo—and I like to add it to a kitchen towel.

Class will concentrate on techniques and steps for machine applique, and we will stitch samples for practice before stitching your project!

Bring: Sewing machine with power cord and foot control

- Open toe presser foot if possible, or foot "N" (Brother) or "B" (Viking)
or any foot with a "groove" on the bottom if possible
- Lightweight tear-away stabilizer (Totally Stable recommended)
- Lightweight bobbin—pre-filled is fine
- Threads to match the project -see photo—I like to use embroidery threads such as Floriani or Exquisite but anything is fine
- Applique press sheet if available (not required)
- Background fabric -fat quarter size OR kitchen towel or toweling
(we sell towels here and also toweling by the yard)
- Basic sewing supplies—scissors, ripper etc

The pattern shows the finished project as a small wall hanging, and we do have samples of the wooden or metal stands here if you choose to do that. Backing and batting will not be included in your kit.
