

**WESTALEE QUILTING PROJECT**  
**RULER WORK**  
**Supply List-Feb 2020**

The original pattern is for a "Ruler Roll" which includes five pockets from mesh or vinyl. You will have these instructions in your pattern, but due to time and "parts"--we will only be making the complete outer piece, which will finish as a runner--9 ¾" X 22". If you have not done the starter class, we will have you do some practice steps on fabric/batting samples.

**Bring:** Pattern "**Ruler Roll**" from Westalee--25% off for class

-Top fabric--13" X 25" (tone on tone)--you will be marking lines on this  
so consider your marker and fabric color when choosing

-Backing--13" X 25"--coordinating fabric

-Batting--Low loft cotton or fusible fleece--same size

-Interfacing--Shape Flex 101--optional for back of top fabric

-Binding--2 ½" X 70" (not needed at the class)

-Sewing machine with power cord and foot control

-Ruler (24") and marker

-Ruler Foot with 12" Arc Template from Starter Pack

-Spacing Gauge

-Sampler Set 1 Templates

-Cross Hair Square--12" preferred

-Extend Table for machine for larger surface

-Thread and bobbin for quilting--50# or 60#

-Screwdriver

-Good needles--Emb 14, topstitch 14, quilting 14 or Purple needle
