

KWIK KRAZY TOTE BAG Supply List

This is a fun bag to make, but might work your brain a bit as you do have to “count” as we work to create different blocks. The idea is sort of a “slice and dice” technique that gives you different looks with each block. Choose fun fabrics that you like, usually following a “theme” or color plan.

Bring: (12) 12” squares of fabric--try to have these cut to 12” before class, but if you don’t we will do it at class **have different colors that co-ordinate or blend so that your bag will have lots of color

½ yard for bag bottom (this shows on the outside)

¾ yard for bag lining

¼ yard for handles

Fat quarter for pocket

Batting--(36” X 45”) such as our Simply cotton batting

Velcro for closure

**we sell all of these things at the sewing center and ask for your class discount

Also--Sewing machine with power cord and foot control

Walking/Even Feed foot

¼” foot

Rotary Cutter

Ruler 12” or 24”

9 ½” or 12 ½” square ruler if possible

Neutral sewing/quilting thread and bobbin

Basic sewing supplies including scissors and ripper

If you have a small iron and mat for your table, that would be great

Pattern “**Kwik Crazy Tote Bag**” required for class-- 25% discount--available at class or before

***The bag body requires some quilting, and this can be done free motion or stitched in lines as a grid--please don’t worry about that step! During class #1 we will get your blocks all cut, stitched, pressed, trimmed and put into a panel. I will help with the quilting!!*
