

Christmas Club-March Embroidery Project

Feltie Santa or Snowman.

Supply List:

Embroidery Machine with power cord

Embroidery Unit

Embroidery Hoop that can hold 5" x 7" design (depending on the size of the design you purchase, a larger hoop may be needed)

Embroidery Foot

USB Stick with design loaded from Nana's Handmade Baby Website.

Felt, Glitter Vinyl or other non-fraying fabric in varying colors (for accents on various pieces of the design) that you wish to use in your design. (18" x 18" over all for base of design needed).

Batting-used to produce a trapunto effect on the design pieces.

Medium Weight Tear A Way Stabilizer. There are several hoopings, so bring enough for 6 hoopings.

6-8 One Inch Alligator clips (These can be purchased at an office supply or Craft store. They will be glued to the back of each design piece, so the finished designs can be attached to a tree)

Embroidery Thread (Bright Green, Red, White, Black, Gold)

Pre-Wound Bobbins (white and also red, green, black)

Embroidery Needles (at least two, 90/14)

Sticky Fabric Glue (Elmer's or other found in craft sections of stores)

Sewing Notions: medium & small straight scissors, applique scissors, seam ripper, etc.

Small Christmas Tree. (Optional) I purchased a tree @ dollar tree during the Christmas season. You may have to wait to add it to a tree when they are back in stock (Dollar Tree!) It also works on a wreath.

When I first attended this class several years ago, the Grinch was the feltie, I made. I was unable to find it on Nana's Handmade site. I am contacting them to see if it still available. If you search the web and find another design, or if you already have one, that is fine! This is a very fun, cute project. I hope you enjoy making it as much as I did.
