

Madeira Heirloom Mat/Pillow

Supply List

- ½ yard fabric for inset fabric**
- 2/3 yard fabric for Madeira frame and backing fabric**
- 1/2 yard Battilizer or fleece**
- 1 1/3 yard insertion lace (you can buy this from Libby)
- 12x14" lightweight tear away stabilizer**
- Fine point wash away marker**
- Glass head pins (or pins you can press on) **
- Size 70 needle**
- Size 90/100 topstitch or #100 wing needle**
- Thread for construction**
- Decorative thread if desired for quilting insert**
- Wash away basting thread**
- Point turner**
- Quilting guide for machine if quilting insert**
- Open toe foot**
- Sewing Machine with power cord**
- 1/4" piecing foot (if available)**
- Basic sewing supplies**
- Fabric scissors
- Small scissors or snips**
- Light box for tracing – this is optional but very helpful if your fabrics are dark in color I will bring a couple to class for those who don't have one.
- I will have the pattern for you at class time.

You will make one placemat or pillow. If making the pillow, you will need Two 17.12.5 rectangles and Fiber fill to make your own pillow.

This was originally made with ½ yard white batiste for mat/pillow with lace shaping and ½ yard pink batiste for madeira frame.
