

IN THE HOOP ZIPPER POUCH

Supply List

Once you learn the basics of these "in the hoop" bags--you will be making lots of them for gifts and your own use! This class will not only take you through the zipper in the hoop technique, but also adding your own text into the appliqué shape on the pouch front.

Bring: Embroidery Machine with embroidery unit and power cord

- Embroidery Foot
- Hoop--minimum 8" wide
- No show mesh or mesh water soluble stabilizer for two hoopings
- Embroidery Needle (I prefer the 90/14)
- Threads to coordinate with your fabrics for quilting and applique
- Quilting (cotton) Bobbin
- 12 to 14" zipper

Fabrics:- 8 ½" squares for lining and back (I used a different lining) (2 total)

- 8 ½" X 14" for front of bag (be careful if directional)
- 8 ½" X 4" for top of pouch (matched to front)
- 6" square for appliqué patch on front (I will have SF101 for you)
- Batting pieces: 1 8" square
 - 1 1" X 8 ½" rectangle
 - 1 6" X 8 ½" rectangle

- Applique scissors (curved point are best)
- Ruler and rotary cutter if fabrics are not pre-cut
- Basic sewing notions such as ripper and marker
