# Rope Bag with Susan "Anything Goes" 

Supply List-March, 2017

## Pattern: Aunties Two Patterns, "Anything Goes"--25\% off at RSC

FabriCBag - 3 yards of fabric or 40 strips $21 / 2$ by $42 / 44$ " (full Jelly Roll)
Binding - $1 / 2$ yard fabric (will need additional fabric $1 / 4$ yards for handles if handmade and 1 yard for pockets)
Fabric Handles - $1 / 4$ yard OR leather handles 22 inches long OR make you own (in the example I purchased pre made handles at JoAnn Fabrics)
Interfacinginterfacing: (for making the tubes) use batting or double sided fusible batting or for a bag that is sturdy in the middle and soft on the sides, used double sided fusible batting in the center 16 strips. (In the example I used battalizer - purchasing 5 yards). The double sided fusible batting $-21 / 2$ yards (the pattern calls for Duet Fuse II by Bosal available in pre-cut rolls of $21 / 4 \times 20$ yards enough for 16 fabric strips). OR Medium Weight Cotton Batting - 3 yards. Please note the tubes made with cotton batting will be soft and slouchy but side seams will be easier to sew.

Matching cotton thread - use a 50 weight 2 ply thread (Aurifil is great)
Handles - Purchase leather handles 22" long OR make your own (instructor has not made handles)
Plastic plumbing tubing (. $1701 / 4$ Polyethylene) 5 feet
Stiff Interfacing (Craf-Tex, Rigid Weave or Peltex) 2 strips $13 / 4 \times 271 / 2$ "
Or you can purchase Aunties Two Happy Handles Kit \#AT238 which contains both the tubing and strips of stiff interfacing pre-cut to $13 / 4$ wide)
Buttons - Inside Pocket - 4 small and 2 medium
Closure - 2 large (or more for the layered look)
1 magnetic sew in button

## Other Necessary Items

Sewing machine in good working order with zig zag stitch-power cord and foot control
Sewing machine needles - MicroTex 90/14 for straight stitches and Jean/Denim 110/18 for zig zag stitching.
Parchment paper
Iron and Ironing board (may use Richland Sewing Center's during class)
Scissors (both large and small)
60 mm Rotary Cutter (consider a new blade as you will be cutting through many layers)
Cutting mat
Acrylic Rulers
Chalk
Seam Ripper
Measuring tape

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## Suggested Pre Work prior to first class

Have 40 strips cut - $21 / 2$ by $42 / 44$ inches long
Have 40 strips of batting cut 2 " by $42 / 44$
