

TEE SHIRT CONVERSION

Supply List

This project is fun and creative--and you should go home with a finished shirt plus "ideas" that you will want to try. I suggest that you bring a good shirt, but keep in mind that the "first run" is a learning process!

Bring: Embroidery Design by DIME--**"Simple to Chic"** or **"Necklines to Hemlines"**

The programs are very similar but the designs are different--choose the one you like best. 25% off for class when purchased here

-Embroidery Machine with embroidery unit, power cord and embroidery foot.

-USB for design transfer

-Hoop--larger size if possible--some designs are 5 X 7"--some larger

**I suggest the "Bella" design in a 6 X 10 or 8 X 12 hoop

-Good embroidery or stretch needle

-Embroidery threads in your color choice (2 to 4 colors)

-Bobbin thread on bobbin (pre-filled is fine)

-Tee shirt with rounded ½" ribbed neckline--no "V" or scooped neck

**pre washing is recommended

-Water soluble topper

-((Water Soluble Sticky--))****one sheet available at class!**

- Mesh Cut-Away Stabilizer and Basting Spray (KK100)

-1 yard cord for lacing (like a shiny shoe lace)

-Awl (or you can use mine at class)

-Chalk-o-liner or something to mark on shirt that will show

**Fusible tricot provided at class

**Some designs also show a sleeve design, back neck design or hemline--it's fun to play!!
