Jelly Roll Rug

Purchase Jelly Roll rug pattern from RSC with class discount.

One Jelly Roll of 2 1/2" strips – you will need 42 strips

or you can cut your own strips from coordinating fabric.

2 rolls of precut 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " batting. You can also use Bosal precut 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " SINGLE sided fusible strips on a roll (this will give more cushion to the rug and is easy to work with)—or cut Fusible Fleece yourself

Large spool of thread to blend with fabrics

#90 or Jean needles

Sewing machine with a wide zig zag and the correct foot for zig zag stitch

1/4" foot

Jerry's Jelly Roll Jig (this tool is VERY helpful and speeds up the process of making the tubes).

To prepare for class:

Keeping your jelly roll in the same order it's rolled in (this usually works best), sew the strips together short end to short end with a diagonal seam. Press seam open. This will give you one continuous length of strips. Refold the strips together to bring to class.

The first class will be about making the tubes. Once you have made several and feel comfortable making them you may leave early and finish this process at home in time for the second class. This takes awhile and you may want to do it over several days.

Second class is making the rug and learning how to shape it and keep it flat.
