

Sixty Degree Runner Supply List

This project is “SEW” fun and fast and makes a wonderful project. Choose your fabric and come prepared to finish the top and get it layered ready to quilt!!

Bring: Border print fabric running with the selvedge--we recommend 2 ½ yards but you can use any amount, just know that your runner will be quite short if you have too little in length. If your border designs are more narrow you can sometimes get two runners from your fabric cut

- 60 Degree Triangle Ruler--we recommend the 12 ½” but smaller is OK
- Straight pins
- Rotary Cutter (sharp blade!)
- 24” Ruler
- Good shears
- Sewing machine with power cord and foot control
- 1/4” foot or setting
- Piecing thread in neutral color plus a bobbin
- Batting--normally 2/3 yard of our Simply is great
- Backing Fabric--if you don't mind a seam in the middle usually a yard is enough, but if your runner is wider it will take more???
- Curved safety pins for layering your runner
