Make an ironing board caddy combining applique, quilt in the hoop and embroidery techniques.

Knowledge or skills needed:

Basic sewing skills needed: sewing straight stitch, working with seam allowances.

Basic machine embroidery skills: working with designs, applique, and stabilizers.

Purchase the pattern at Richland Sewing Center BEFORE coming to class. Print the directions.
Load the designs from the CD onto a USB stick BEFORE coming to class.

SUPPLY LIST

Cut away mesh stabilizer

Batting - cotton Battilizer okay

Lightweight tearaway stabilizer

Spray adhesive, painter's tape or pink embroiderer's tape

Small applique trimming scissors

Ruler or tape measure

Rotary cutter with at least 12" ruler

Fabric: Richland has several sewing-themed fabric collections!

½ yd base fabric (shown in blue floral)

¼ yd pocket fabric (shown in yellow check)

⅛ yd fabric for the pocket sashing (shown in yellow)

¼ yd fabric for the caddy sashing (shown in yellow)

⅛ yd fabric for the pocket binding (shown in yellow)

¼ yd fabric for the pocket lining

¾ yd fabric for the caddy backing

⅛ yd fabric for the binding

Scraps of appliqué fabric

First Class May 13:

Embroidery Machine with embroidery arm and power cord

5 x 7" standard hoop

Embroidery thread for quilting and designs

Embroidery needles (75/11 sharps preferred)

Embroidery bobbin with bobbin thread

Second Class May 20: assembly of blocks DO NOT TRIM YOUR BLOCKS UNTIL YOU GET TO CLASS

- Sewing Machine with sewing feet, power cord (embroidery set up not needed)
- Sewing notions: seam gauge, seam ripper, pins, small ruler, temporary marking pen
- Sewing needles (80/12), thread to match fabric, bobbin.
- Rotary cutter with at least 12" ruler
- Wonder clips options!
