SUPPLY LIST FOR SNOW DATE PILLOWS CHRISTMAS EMBROIDERY MAY 22

Purchase designs from Richland Sewing Center. Decide which design (boy or girl) you want to do for class. **LOAD on to a USB-or we can help you with that.**

- USB with your loaded designs This will have 2 different parts per design.
- Print out your directions & bring to class so that you can make notes during class.
- Mesh cutaway Stabilizer to accommodate your hoop size***
- Fusible webbing such as Steam a Seam Lite (1 yard)***
- Fusible Woven Interfacing such as Shape Flex (1yd)***
- Hoop Choices: 5x7, 8x8, 6x10, 7x12 or 8.5x14 (What I used for the large 13x13" pillow) or 10.5x16
- White Fabric-1/2 yd for EACH pillow***
- Main Fabric (Non-directional)-1 &1/4 yd. for EACH Pillow*** (I like to buy extra in case of boo-boos)
- Mitten Fabric -6"x4" fabric for EACH Pillow***Mitten Cuff Fabric 5"x3" fabric for EACH
- Embroidery thread for project. You will need white & other threads to match your main fabric & other fabrics (including mittens and mitten cuffs, and snowflakes)***
- WASH AWAY THREAD (Not invisible thread)***
- Pillow Form for your size of pillow. Refer to directions for your size hoop
- Embroidery tape***Embroidery bobbins***Small, curved embroidery scissors***
- Empty bobbins***Microtex Sharp Needles size 80/12***
- Basic sewing supplies Marking Pen that irons away***
- KK100 Temporary Adhesive Spray***Spray Starch***
- Embroidery Machine- Embroidery Unit -POWER CORD
- Sewing machine with <u>regular foot and ¼" foot</u> and power cord. If you have a combo embroidery machine you do not have to bring a separate sewing machine. Just bring the stuff to change over to sewing to finish the pillow.
- 8-10" Velcro for EACH Pillow**
- Rotary Cutter***6x24" ruler*** Large square ruler if available (15-18")
- ½ yd. Ribbon for Girls bowl used a more narrow ribbon for the guys bow tie or you can use a scrap of fabric for the bow tie.
