

CLASS SUPPLY LIST KNIT JACKET

You will construct a loose-fitting jacket with a self-lined front using McCall's® pattern M7331.

This is an easy pattern with excellent instructions written by Nancy Zieman. You will also learn techniques for working with and sewing on knit fabrics.



Supplies you need to bring:

1. Pattern: McCall's M7331

If your full bust measurement is 38" or more, buy the larger size group. *Do not buy the pattern based on your Ready to Wear dress size*

2. Fabric: This pattern is for knits only. Select a medium weight moderate stretch knit. A good ponte knit or double knit works well. Look on pattern envelope for yardage needed. (Buy additional yardage if you wish to later make the coordinating pieces.)
3. Sewing machine, power cord, foot pedal. Sewing feet.
4. Stretch or jersey sewing machine needles
5. Sharp pins! Or pattern weights.
6. Fabric shears
7. Fabric marking pen or tracing wheel and paper.
8. Tape measure
9. Seam gauge
10. Seam ripper
11. Coordinating color of sewing thread and wound bobbins. (Embroidery thread is not suitable.)
12. Lightweight fusible interfacing (approx. 16" square).
