

Please read over pattern before class.

You should be able to either finish or get really close to finishing in class.

Cut strips by 22" or the full WOF 44".

If you can have the strips sewn together long-ways before class, it will save some time. Any combination of 1-1/2" to 3-1/2" wide by 22" or 42" long (jelly roll strips can be used). Once all strips are sewn together, they should measure approx. 54-56" long, using a ¼" seam allowance.



Materials

(based on 42-wide fabric) If using fat quarters, they must measure 18" x 22"

Pockets (front outside) 3 quarter yard pieces

Lining (Bag & Pockets) I-2/3 yard

Fabric Strips for Bag 30 Strips, widths from

I-I/2" to 3-I/2 " x 22"

Permanent Press Muslin 3/4 yard

I" Webbing 4 yards

Fusible Interfacing 40" wide 2 yards (Deco Bond)

Batting 3/4 yard

Binding I/3 yard

Additional Supplies Needed:

- Sewing Machine, Power Cord, Pedal and Walking/Quilting Foot
- Printed Pattern
- Your choice of fabrics
- Coordinating Threads, and Super Mono Poly Invisible thread
- Sewing Supplies: (Scissors, Top Stitch Needles, 6-1/2" x 24" ruler, rotary cutter, seam ripper, bobbins, etc.)
