### Supply List and Prep

Following is a “schedule” of you quilt project for the next three months so that you can plan and be prepared: **July**—We will stitch the pintucks for Block #7—

You will have a demo of #8—creating piping and have the pattern

**August**—Demo of the Fringe Foot for #9

Demo of Bobbin Work for #10

Patterns handed out for 9 and 10 to work on

**September**—Demo of Chenille for Block #11—stitch in class

Demo of Rick Rack & Fringe Foot for #12

Patterns handed out for 11 & 12

As you can see, we are “doubling up” a bit so that you can work on the background quilting and basic applique at home, and work on the “techniques” at the classes. I will let you know with supply lists just what to bring for each class. If you miss class and want the info, you will need to pay for the session and I will have the handouts for you. I will try to catch anyone up on techniques at class times. You all are doing so great and I love your sharing at class!!

**For July:** Bring—Sewing machine, power cord and foot control

- Pintuck foot if possible (open toe if not available)

- 2.0 twin needle

- Fabric for practice, and **fabric for insert 6” square-don’t starch!**

- Try to have the big flower (piece #6) fused and ready to cut

- two threads for pintucking that match (one can be a filled bobbin)

- Basics for applique and/or quilting the block

IF you have a **piping foot or zipper foot**, please bring that to class -photo below shows the piping around the block that you will do next!
