Embroidery or Universal needle 80/12 (bring at least 2)

Embroidery notions: Small sharp pointed scissors; ruler, rotary cutter, making pens, etc.

Since this design pack has several new techniques, I will concentrate on the following:.

cutwork design, fringed design (includes applique) and snow globe design (includes applique).

Cutwork Design: (bells or poinsettia)

Water Soluble Stabilizer

Fusible woven or non-woven stabilizer (Ex. Shape Flex, ArmoWeft)

Fabric: 2 (6x6") pieces for background and backing

Bamboo Hoop 3 ½" or 4" diameter

12" --3/8" ribbon Pom-Pom trim

Co-ordinating embroidery thread

Embroidery Bobbin

Fringed Design: (Santa or Tree)

Cut-away Stabilizer

Fabric 1: 2 (6x6") pieces for background and backing

Fabric 2: only needed for face of Santa

Glitter Applique Sheet in Red & White for Santa Hat

Pom-pom trim 12" 3/8" Ribbon

12 3/8 1100011

Bamboo Hoop 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " or 4" diameter

Coordinating embroidery thread

Embroidery Bobbin

Snow Globe Design: Snowman

Cut-away Stabilizer

Fabric 1: 2 (6x6") pieces for background and backing

Fabric 2: for snowman 3x4"

Glitter Applique Sheet in Red & White for Snowman Hat

Clear Vinyl (6x6")

Snow Globe Filler 1/8 Tsp. (Ex. Seguins, confetti, tiny foam balls, etc)

Pom-pom trim 12" 3/8" Ribbon

Bamboo Hoop 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " or 4" diameter

Coordinating embroidery thread

Embroidery Bobbin
