FRUIT TART AND PIE TRIVET

RICHLAND SEWING CENTER

Supply List August 2017



Class Description:

You will make a tart-size coaster resembling a fruit pie. You will also receive a design for a larger size “fruit pie trivet”. When you register for the course inform Richland Sewing Center which brand of embroidery machine you will bring.

Supplies you need to bring:

1. USB stick to transfer design.
2. Fat quarter of beige or light tan fabric suitable for the “crust”. It should have minimal pattern and “read solid”. Many good selections are available at Richland Sewing Center.
3. Thread: Embroidery thread to match your “crust fabric”. Wind one full bobbin with this thread or bobbin thread of similar color.
4. ¼” wide Steam a Seam tape or similar product
5. Fabric-type water soluble stabilizer. Floriani Wet n Gone® is ideal.
6. Embroidery sewing machine and accessories (foot pedal, power cord, embroidery module, embroidery foot, embroidery needles)
 - Hoop for coaster: 5” x 7” or 6” x 6”.
 - Hoop for pie trivet: 8” x 8” or 9” x 12”
7. Scissors: Fabric scissors. Applique scissors. Embroidery trim scissors
8. Rotary cutter. Cutting ruler at least 12” long
9. Sewing notions: pins, scissors, ruler or tape measure, seam ripper, temporary fabric marker

KIT supplied for you – there will be a kit fee of \$8.00 to be paid to

Instructor:

Designs for both the coaster and the trivet. Bring a USB stick.
Several 5” squares of berry fabric. My choice.
A 7 x 7” square of berry fabric for the trivet.
Wool batting sized and cut for tart
Heat-removable topper



OPTIONAL: mini-iron and portable ironing pad to press lattice strips. (Will save bottleneck at ironing board)
