## I Believe, or Santa is Coming to Town

If you want to finish your pillow in class, you will need to have cut all the fabric and Fusible Shape Flex (SF101) and iron the Fusible Shape Flex on the back of the appropriate fabric. (Fabric requirements on 2<sup>nd</sup> page)

- Matching threads-Stabilizer Tear Away
- Embroidery Bobbin Thread 2 ea
- Rotary Cutter and Ruler
- Extra Embroidery Machine Needles
- Straight Pens
- Turning Tool
  
- Embroidery Machine w/Power Cord
- Embroidery Unit
- Embroidery Foot
- Embroidery Hoop 6 " x 10" Minimum
  
- Sewing Machine w/Power Cord (or ankle for combo machines)
- Foot Control
- ¼" foot or Standard Sewing Foot
- Zipper foot

## Santa is Coming to Town

### Fabric

1/3 yd gray fabric or 9 ½" square  
2 ½ " x 18 ½ accent strip of pillow (back of pillow  
and accent strip can be the same gray fabric  
no shape flex on this piece)  
¾ yd red fabric  
3" x 6" scrap for the hat  
5" x 6" scrap for the beard and face  
2" square scrap for the pom pom on hat  
Three 5" square asst green fabrics for trees

### Cutting the Fabric

From Gray fabric & shape flex  
One 9 ½" square. Press shape flex to the back of  
fabric.

### White Fabric

3" x 6" scrap for the hat  
5" x 6" scrap for the beard and face  
2" square for the pom-pom

### Other Materials

½ yards Fusible Shape Flex 101  
Tear Away Stabilizer  
22" zipper to match backing fabric  
  
18" Pillow Form  
Water Soluble Pen  
Paper Tape

### From Red Fabric

Four 6 ½" x 9 ½" rectangles  
Four 6 ½" squares  
One 6 ½" x 18 12" pillow back  
One 12 ½" x 18 1/2" pillow Back

### Assorted Green's

Three 5" square for trees

## I Believe Santa Pillow

### Fabric

½ yard background fabric (mine is gray)  
1/3 yd border print (mine is red)  
½ yd backing fabric (mine is red)  
4" x 7" scrap for the heat  
7" x 8" scrap for the beard and face

### Cutting The Fabric

From background fabric & shape flex  
One 14" square

From backing fabric & shape flex  
One 6 ½" x 18 ½" rectangle

### Other Materials

1 ½ yds Fusible Shape Flex SF101  
Tear Away stabilizer  
22" zipper to match backing fabric  
18" Pillow Form  
Water Soluble Pen  
Paper Tape

### From Border Print and shape flex

Two 3 ½" x 13" rectangles  
Two 3 ¼" x 18 ½" rectangle  
One 2 ½" x 18 ½" rectangle zipper flap  
(no shape flex on this piece)
