

# The Potato Chip Bag

## Supply List

If this is the first time you are making this bag, please use cotton fabric only.

1 Potato Chip Bag pattern\*\*--available at Richland Sewing Center

1 fat quarter – Purse front, back, back pocket & flap

1 fat quarter – Lining front, back and & 2 lining pockets

(I used a different color on my lining pockets)

1 fat quarter – Front pocket / straps

½ yard of 44" wide Fusible Mid-weight Interfacing

(1 yard if 22" wide) I used Battilizer for my bag for the stiffness.

You can also use Pellon 987F fusible fleece. Or Pellon SF101.

\*\*Fat quarters must measure at least 18" across



(Optional) If you want to make an adjustable strap, you will also need the 2 1" strap keeper loops and 1 1" slide buckle. Snap or other closure if wanted.

If you have your fabric cut out before getting to class, it will go faster. You could go home with a finished product.

Sewing Machine in good working order

attachments, power cord and foot control.

Walking foot, regular stitch foot, etc.. (You may or may not need it, It will depend on the fabric/ batting you choose.)

machine needles, prewound bobbins, coordinating threads, scissors, marking pen or chalk, small ruler, rotary cutter.
