

## WESTALEE QUILTING PROJECT

### Supply List

This is a chance to put your Westalee Quilting Rulers to good use, and get some practice on a “real” block. It would be helpful if you have taken the beginner class, or at least have worked with the rulers and ruler foot, but all are welcome.

I made up a “4-Block” sample, to show different colors and to give myself plenty of practice! It gets more fun the more you do!!! In class we will do some practice work, and then work through at least one “real” block.

**Bring:** Sewing machine with power cord and foot control

- Sew Steady Table
- Free Motion Slider if possible
- Westalee Starter Kit--ruler foot, 12” arc ruler and spacer
- Westalee Sampler Set 1--we are using the “Spinning Wheel 36” and the positioning thumb tacks
- 12” Crosshair ruler if possible--this is important for pre-marking
- Washable or iron-off marker that will show on your fabric
- Cotton thread and matching bobbin for your fabric
- New topstitch, quilting 14 or denim 14 needle

**Fabric:** Practice “sandwich” of muslin or textured fabric (top, batting and back) at least 12”

- Project fabric--16” square of fabric (tone on tone, marble or shadowplay) with batting and backing
- 4 curved safety pins to secure
- Seam ripper, small scissors and any general supplies you need
