Kimberbell Embroidery Holiday Pillow September 16, 2022 10:00 A.M.

This project allows you to choose between a Halloween or Christmas design. The design is included in the cost of the class. Please read this supply list thoroughly. There is a lot of information included for class preparation.



Supplies:

Embroidery Machine with power cord and Embroidery Foot

Embroidery Hoop: The overall design is 11" x 9", a hoop that accommodates this size design is required.

Embroidery Needles, 75/11 (always have a few spares for emergencies)

Sewing foot and foot control for pillow construction.

Sewing Needle, 80/12

USB stick for transfer of design

Fabric:

15" x 15" light colored fabric. This is the base for the design.

Prep this fabric with Jeannie's spray (1/3 Best Press; 1/3 Terial Magic and 1/3 water). Mist onto the fabric, let dry and press. Back this fabric with SF 101 (Woven or non-woven-your choice) or use spray sizing of your choice

Three different Half-Fat 1/8th (9" x 11") fabrics for the shoe applique

Prep the back of these fabrics with fusible web such as Heat 'N Bond Lite

One Fat $1/8^{th}$ (9" x 21") for inner border.

This will be cut into 4 strips of 1 1/2"

Four 2 ½" x 20" strips of fabric for the flange. (I did use seven different fabrics 2 ½" squares, 4 each for the Halloween pillow).

Back these strips with SF 101.

½ Yard for back of pillow.

Cut-Away Mesh Fusible Stabilizer.

Thread to coordinate with your fabrics.

Embroidery Bobbins

Piecing Thread

Sewing bobbin

22" zipper to match the back of pillow fabric.

Wonder Tape

Sewing Notions: rotary cutter, ruler, centering ruler, marking pen or chalk runner, pins, etc.
