

## CHENILLE Supply List

-This technique is so fun and easy—and Jane “teaches” it weekly at the cutting table—just hints to customers and so many ask. In this class we will make a table topper (round) or a rectangular place mat, and from there you can make anything!

Bring: Machine in good working order with power cord and foot control

- Walking Foot for machine
- Marking pen to draw lines on fabric-be sure it will show on your fabric
- Thread to match your back fabric and your binding
- 24” ruler with a 45 degree line marked
- Chenille Cutter (available RSC)
- (3) 5” wide strips WOF for binding \*\*if making the round mat, these must be bias

For placemat—2 pieces of fabric 18” X 20” (one of these is the back)

1 piece of batting 18” X 20”

3 pieces of fabric for the top cut 17” X 19”

For round topper—same as above but make sizes 20” squares

Please try to have fabrics cut and ready before class
