

“SPRUCE IT UP”

Supply List--December 11, 2020 @ 10:00

It's a little hard to make up a list for this class, as it all depends on how many trees you plan to make, or how large a project. I made a wall hanging with five trees and two “rail fence” blocks (all embroidery!), but you could make a runner or a full quilt--or a pillow! I will give cutting for one tree and you plan for that--or just bring lots of greens and reds and we will figure it out!!

Bring:

- **USB--Design will be provided at the class-- included in class fee
- Embroidery Machine with embroidery unit and foot and power cord
- 9" X 14" hoop
- Mesh stabilizer to fit hoop
- Batting--1/3 yard of “Simply” cut to 16 X 12” pieces
- Scissors, rotary cutter and ruler (24")

Fabrics: 6 different red fabrics--1/2 yard each makes the quilt but you won't need that much for a smaller project.

ONE Tree block takes (4) strips 4" X 11" -same fabric
(pre-cut at least one set of strips before class if possible)

- Background (mine is cream with dots)--5" X 10" rectangle
- Green (or your choice) for tree--7 ½" X 11"
- Star--3 ½" square
- Tree Trunk--2 ½" square

One Rail Fence Block--5 different red strips cut to 3" X 10 ½"
-11" batting square

- Embroidery or Quilting threads for piecing, appliqué and quilting
- Embroidery Bobbins
- Good machine needle (embroidery 14 or quilting 14 preferred)

Border, Backing and Binding fabrics will be determined when you put yours together!!

**I plan to add sparkle/crystals to my trees when finished
