The doors will open in the Arts and Crafts Building on Thurs at **9:00 AM**. Please no early birds including dropping off stuff. We need time to get everything set up before our campers move in. Also, please do not ask the fairgrounds staff if you can put your stuff in the room.

Meals:

Daily Breakfast is on your own.

Lunch will be provided Thursday, Friday and Saturday.

Dinner will be provided on Thurs, and Friday. (NEW! No dinner will be served on Saturday.)

We will serve a sweet treat around 3 PM as a little "pick me up". This replaces dessert at each meal.

We are feeding the masses and are not able to accommodate special dietary requests.

Schedule:

Thurs: Doors open 9 am – sewing ends at 11 pm. Demo with Carol or Barb time TBD.

Friday: Doors open at 8 am – sew until 11 PM. Demos with Carol and Barb, time TBD.

Sat: Doors open at 8 am – sew until 7 PM. Demo with Carol or Barb, time TBD. Pack up and move out by 8 PM.

Items provided: Six ironing stations, two elevated cutting tables with mats, one portable design wall.

Items to bring: Sewing equipment – machine, ***extension cord for wall to your table***, multi-plug outlet, rotary cutter and rulers, as many projects as you want, favorite sewing chair or a seat cushion (optional), your own Accuquilt cutter (we will not be bringing ours). ***Your own portable design wall if you'll need one for an extended period of time.*** Your own beverage of choice (we will have ice water, ice tea and coffee), one snack item to share. Snack assignment is by last name: Thurs A-G, Fri H-P, Sat Q-Z. If you want to store cold drinks, please provide your own ice chest and ice.

Notes: You may bring your small irons and ironing boards but we ask that you turn them off unless needed.

No large irons at the tables, please.

Wear layers and bring a small personal fan and/or a light jacket if you are prone to being too hot or cold.

Quilt Corral will have a pop-up store on site.
