The doors will open in the Arts and Crafts Building on Weds Jul 18th at 10:00 AM. Please no early birds. You may drop stuff off outside the door if you'd like but please keep in mind that we need time to get everything set up before campers move in.

## **Meals:**

Daily Breakfast is on your own.

Lunch will be provided on Weds, Thurs, and Friday. Please note that we will serve lunch the first day.

Dinner on Weds and Thurs is provided. Dinner on Friday is an appetizer potluck. (More details below).

## **Schedule:**

Weds Jul 18: Doors open 10 am – sewing ends at midnight.

Thurs Jul 19: Doors open at 8 am – sew until midnight. Accuquilt demo with Carol, time TBD.

Fri Jul 20: Doors open at 8 am. At 6 pm we will celebrate all our finished UFOS with an appetizer potluck followed by show and tell of projects you've made on retreat. Sew until midnight. Please pack up your sewing station before going to bed.

Sat Jul 21: Doors open at 7 am to load up your sewing stuff. We must be out by 10 am.

**Items provided:** Three ironing stations, two elevated cutting tables with mats, one portable design wall, clothesline to stretch around the room for displaying projects.

**Items to bring:** Sewing equipment – machine, extension cord, multi-plug outlet, rotary cutter and rulers, as many projects as you want, favorite sewing chair or a seat cushion (optional). Your own portable design wall if you'll need one for an extended period of time. An extra table if you'll need one. Your own beverage of choice (we will have ice tea, water and coffee), one snack item to share, one appetizer item for the Friday potluck (or team up with a friend). We will have a full kitchen – you may prep your appetizer there and/or store it in the community fridge.

**Notes:** You may bring your small irons and ironing boards but since we don't know the electrical capacity of the room we ask that you keep them off unless needed.

Wear layers and bring a small personal fan if you are prone to being too hot.

Quilt Corral will have a pop-up store on site and we will have our Accuquilt cutting machines on hand to try.
