#### Class Policies:

- Classes must be paid for at time of registration. One week cancellation notice required for refund or credit fees. For blocks of the month, the upcoming session must be paid for BEFORE the date of the session.
- It is important to have all your materials before class begins and to have your sewing machine set up and ready to sew. Our teachers make every effort to start on time.
- All brands of sewing machines and sergers are welcome.
- As a courtesy to others, please turn off cell phones during class. If you must take a call, please step out of the classroom to limit disruption to the class.
- Small, basic, non-embroidery machines may be available for \$10.00 rental fee at time of registration.
- This class is for the specific project as described here. If you wish to make something different, it should be done outside of class.
- **PLEASE** do not use perfumes, colognes, scented hair products, or lotions prior to class, so that those with allergies or asthma may enjoy the class as well.

#### Supplies you will need:

- Embroidery/sewing machine in good working order with power cord, foot control, slide on tray and a new needle. Be sure to bring your sewing machine instruction book if you are sewing on something other than a BERNINA.
- **Basic Sewing Supplies**
  - Good quality fabric scissors
  - Small scissors or snips
  - Seam ripper
  - Straight pins
  - Fabric marker
  - Extra machine needles
  - Pen & paper for notes
  - Anything else you commonly use for a day of sewing!
- Rotary cutter, ruler and mat. I will be showing some new square up rulers that you will be able to order if you wish.

- **Broomhilda's Bakery** machine embroidery pattern from Kimberbell. Please purchase from the store before class. You will need to load the embroidery designs into your machine or to a stick prior to coming to class. Please read the sizes needed for the quilt so you only load those designs.
- Fabric requirements as listed in the book or you can get out all of your Halloween fabrics and use them to create a one of a kind wallhanging.
- Ultra Clean & Tear stabilizer in the size that best fits your large oval hoop or your 6 x 8 hoop. You will also need enough of Polymesh stabilizer to fit this hoop 4 times. Do not forget to prewash it.
- Decorative threads that will go best with your fabrics and some metallics to give it a little pop. Please do not forget your bobbin thread and at least one bobbin that has a dark color of thread on it for a few of the designs.
- Glue stick (Elmers School glue works best)
- Your favorite curved scissors for cutting around the appliqués.

**Before coming to class:**

- Be sure to load your designs and you might consider some of your fabrics choices.
- We will be discussing the embellishments and other items. You do not need to get the vinyl, or the mylar as I will be providing these.
