Class Policies:

- It is important to have all your materials before class begins and to have your sewing machine set up and ready to sew. Our teachers make every effort to start on time.
- All brands of sewing machines and sergers are welcome.
- As a courtesy to others, please turn off cell phones during class. If you must take a call, please step out of the classroom to limit disruption to the class.
- Loaner machines are available for \$10.00 rental fee at time of registration.
- This class is for the specific project as described here. If you wish to make something different, it should be done outside of class.
- **PLEASE** do not use perfumes, colognes, scented hair products, or lotions prior to class, so that those with allergies or asthma may enjoy the class as well.

Supplies you will need:

- Sewing machine in good working order with power cord, foot control, slide on tray table and a new needle. Be sure to bring your machine instruction book if you are sewing on something other than a BERNINA.
- **Basic Sewing Supplies**
 - Good quality fabric scissors
 - Small scissors or snips
 - Seam ripper
 - Straight pins
 - Friction marker
 - Extra machine needles
 - Pen & paper for notes
 - Anything else you commonly use for a day of sewing!
- The book **"Simple, Fun, & Quickly Done"** purchased from the store. This is the first of many items that we are going to be creating this year.
- Thread as needed for your design. You can either match your fabrics or use variegated. You will need both thread for construction and then thread for the quilting and finishing.
- Feet - # 97 or 97D, Walking foot with the blade and your open toed appliqué foot #20, 20C or 20D

- Fabric
 - 1 fat quarter for the inner section, backing, and binding.
 - 1 fat quarter for the outer rind and binding
 - 3" strip of white x WOF (42).
 - 6" x 11" Insulbrite
 - 6" x 11" batting
- A Dresden wedge ruler that measures up to the drawing on page 10 or your book. Rotary cutter and mat. You will also need a ruler that is approx 6" x 12" long.
- A hand sewing needle.

Before coming to class:

Starch and press your fat quarters and the white fabric.
