Class Policies:

- Classes must be paid for at time of registration. One week cancellation notice required for refund or credit fees. For blocks of the month, the upcoming session must be paid for BEFORE the date of the session.
- It is important to have all your materials before class begins and to have your sewing machine set up and ready to sew. Our teachers make every effort to start on time.
- All brands of sewing machines and sergers are welcome.
- As a courtesy to others, please turn off cell phones during class. If you must take a call, please step out of the classroom to limit disruption to the class.
- Small, basic, non-embroidery machines may be available for \$10.00 rental fee at time of registration.
- This class is for the specific project as described here. If you wish to make something different, it should be done outside of class.
- PLEASE do not use perfumes, colognes, scented hair products, or lotions prior to class, so that those with allergies or asthma may enjoy the class as well.

Supplies you will need:

- Sewing machine in good working order with power cord, foot control, slide on tray and a new needle. Be sure to bring your sewing machine instruction book if you are sewing on something other than a BERNINA.
- **Basic Sewing Supplies**
 - Good quality fabric scissors
 - Small scissors or snips
 - Seam ripper
 - Straight pins
 - Fabric marker
 - Extra machine needles
 - Pen & paper for notes
 - Anything else you commonly use for a day of sewing!
- Rotary cutter, ruler - a 24" long and another, 6 ½ - 7" square
- Feet –
 - Multi purpose foot (#1/1C/1D)
 - Open toe embroidery foot (#20/20C/20D)

- Edge Stitch foot (#10/10C/10D)
- Circular Embroidery Attachment
- Regular Embroidery foot (#15)
- Thread –
 - You will need 6 – 10 colors of embroidery thread. These should be threads that are used in your embroideries and you will also need 1 for a pop of color.
 - Bobbin thread
- Design Package – I used Chloe from OESD but if you do not wish to use this you may use a design pack of your own choosing. You will need to have different sizes ranging from 2" x 3" to 5" x 7". You will also need your designs to have thin designs like the leaf patterns in different lengths. If you are in doubt please check with me.
- Fabric – 4-5 yards of a fabric that reads as a slight solid. You do not want a lot of pattern as it will fight with your decorative stitches and your embroideries. You may want 5 yards for the front, as it will allow for 'do overs'. You will need approx 4 yards for the backing. Your batting will depend on your final finished size. Please use batting that will allow you to only quilt approx every 8 inches, such as Warm & Natural (no more than 10 inches.) You will need extra fabric to practice your stitches so please come prepared for this. You will need 1 full roll of Ultra Clean & Tear stabilizer, size 20" wide x 10 yards.
- Hoops – You will need to bring all of your hoops, templates, clips, and a package of Tearaway Tape.
- Optional items that will be helpful
 - If it has been a while since you have had your machine cleaned it is wise to have it checked out before you start this project.
 - Manual for your machine
 - High tension embroidery bobbin case (yellow)-available for BERNINA 5 & 7 Series
 - Extra empty bobbins
 - Scissors for both fabric and thread
 - Glasses or machine magnifier will be helpful
 - Fabric marking pen that disappears with heat or water. The markers that disappear with air will not work. Please be aware that chalk sometimes does not come out because of sizing in the fabric.

Before coming to class:

- The purpose of this class is to familiarize you with decorative stitches built into your machine, special feet and attachments. We will be creating stitch recipes, sharing ideas and generally having a great time.

- I realize there are many supplies that we will be using throughout the class but you will not need all of them all the time. Please bring all to the first class and from then on you will be told at the end of class what you will need for the next class.
- Fabric and thread are the most important items and they need to be at every class along with your machine. I have set up the class so that sometimes you will not use your machine. There will be homework that needs to be done before each class. We will be working on several blocks each class so you will not be finishing each block each session.
- I am willing to help you with fabric, thread, and design ideas but please make arrangements and do not disturb other classes.
