Class Policies:

- Classes must be paid for at time of registration. One week cancellation notice required for refund or credit fees. For blocks of the month, the upcoming session must be paid for BEFORE the date of the session.
- It is important to have all your materials before class begins and to have your sewing machine set up and ready to sew. Our teachers make every effort to start on time.
- All brands of sewing machines and sergers are welcome.
- As a courtesy to others, please turn off cell phones during class. If you must take a call, please step out of the classroom to limit disruption to the class.
- Small, basic, non-embroidery machines are available for \$10.00 rental fee at time of registration.
- This class is for the specific project as described here. If you wish to make something different, it should be done outside of class.
- PLEASE do not use perfumes, colognes, scented hair products, or lotions prior to class, so that those with allergies or asthma may enjoy the class as well.

Supplies you will need:

- Sewing machine in good working order with power cord, foot control, slide on tray and a new needle. Be sure to bring your sewing machine instruction book if you are sewing on something other than a BERNINA.
- **Basic Sewing Supplies**
 - Good quality fabric scissors
 - Small scissors or snips
 - Seam ripper
 - Straight pins
 - Fabric marker
 - Extra machine needles
 - Pen & paper for notes
 - Anything else you commonly use for a day of sewing!
- **Pattern "Colors of Fall"**
- Rotary cutter, mat, a 6" x 12" or any size you can measure 7" x 1", and 1 ¼"
- Straight pins for pinning you appliquéés together.

- Thread for construction, and decorative thread for the appliqué and quilting. Please remember you will also need thread for your bobbin to match or contrast your backing when you are quilting, so do not forget empty bobbins.
- ¼" foot and your open toed appliqué foot along with your walking foot, if you have one.
- Teflon pressing sheet
- Fabric – I used all 2 ½" strips but if you have lots of fat quarters you can use them. Please cut one 2 ½" strip from each fat quarter before coming to class and bring all of the extra fabric just in case.
 - 1/8 yard of 7 different oranges in varying degrees from light to dark
 - 1/8 yard of 7 different reds to burgundy fabrics again in varying degrees
 - 1/8 yard of 5 different yellows also in varying degrees, I even threw in a few yellow greens. Remember leaves are changing colors.
 - Scraps of Green for stems and squiggles
 - 4 - 12" squares of background
 - 1½ yards of sashing, borders and backing fabric – this is so you do not have to piece the backing, or borders.
 - 19" x 54" batting and/or 4 pieces 14x18 inches for placemats
 - You will also need about a yard of fusible web, such as Heat & Bond Lite, Bosal or Lite Steam-a-Seam.

Before coming to class:

You can cut the 2 ½" strips but all of the rest of the cutting will be done in class.
