**Class Policies:**

- Classes must be paid for at time of registration. One week cancellation notice required for refund or credit fees. For blocks of the month, the upcoming session must be paid for BEFORE the date of the session.
- It is important to have all your materials before class begins and to have your sewing machine set up and ready to sew. Our teachers make every effort to start on time.
- All brands of sewing machines and sergers are welcome.
- **As a courtesy to others, please turn off cell phones during class. If you must take a call, please step out of the classroom to limit disruption to the class.**
- Small, basic, non-embroidery machines are available for \$10.00 rental fee at time of registration.
- This class is for the specific project as described here. If you wish to make something different, it should be done outside of class.
- **PLEASE do not use perfumes, colognes, scented hair products, or lotions prior to class, so that those with allergies or asthma may enjoy the class as well.**

**Supplies you will need:**

- Embroidery machine in good working order with power cord, foot control, All of the items that came with your embroidery and a new needle.
- **Basic Sewing Supplies**
  - Good quality fabric scissors
  - 6" seam gauge/ruler with slide
  - Straight pins
  - Extra machine needles
  - Anything else you commonly use for a day of sewing!
  - Small scissors for threads
  - Seam ripper
  - Fabric marker to contrast
  - Pen & paper for notes
- Thread - you will need all of the threads that are called for in the design that you choose. The design needs to be no bigger than 2.5 inches x 3.5 inches. If you want a long but thinner design it needs to be 1½" high x 4" wide. Please pick a couple of ideas and I will be able to help you settle on the easiest.

- Stabilizer – we will be using Hydro Stick stabilizer and I will be providing it in sizes to fit your hoop. You will need the hoop that is closest to a 5" x 7".
- Feet – You will need to have your embroidery foot. I like the #15 (a larger opening) because it rides higher and is more open to see the embroidery better.

**Before coming to class:**

Make sure, if you are using a design that is not in your machine, that you put the USB stick in and see that the machine reads it. I will also have a visor for each sewer in case we have time to embroider it. You will need a design that is no taller than 1½" and can be 4" in length.
