Class Policies:

- Classes must be paid for at time of registration. One week cancellation notice required for refund or credit fees. For blocks of the month, the upcoming session must be paid for BEFORE the date of the session.
- It is important to have all your materials before class begins and to have your sewing machine set up and ready to sew. Our teachers make every effort to start on time.
- All brands of sewing machines and sergers are welcome.
- As a courtesy to others, please turn off cell phones during class. If you must take a call, please step out of the classroom to limit disruption to the class.
- Small, basic, non-embroidery machines are available for \$10.00 rental fee at time of registration.
- This class is for the specific project as described here. If you wish to make something different, it should be done outside of class.
- PLEASE do not use perfumes, colognes, scented hair products, or lotions prior to class, so that those with allergies or asthma may enjoy the class as well.

Supplies you will need:

- Embroidery/Sewing machine in good working order with power cord, foot control, slide on tray and a new needle. Be sure to bring your sewing machine instruction book if you are sewing on something other than a BERNINA.
- **Basic Sewing Supplies**
 - Good quality fabric scissors
 - Small scissors or snips
 - Seam ripper
 - Straight pins
 - Fabric marker
 - Extra machine needles
 - Pen & paper for notes
 - Anything else you commonly use for a day of sewing!
- Rotary cutter, ruler and mat.
- **Jingle All the Way** machine embroidery pattern from Kimberbell. Please purchase from the store before class. You will need to load the embroidery design onto a stick or directly into your machine. I used

the 5x7 size of the Whimsy tree and the Christmas house. Please be sure to check it and make sure that your machine is reading it. Please do not forget to bring your book.

- Feet – You will need your favorite ¼" foot (#97/97D), your favorite embroidery foot, a walking foot for the second class, and your open-toed appliqué foot (#20/#20C/20D).
- Fabric requirements –
 - You will need several different prints and patterns for the houses.
 - You will need fabric for the inner border, patchwork border according to the book, page 23.
 - You will need five background pieces that are 8 ½" x 10 ½" or larger for the embroidery to be sewn on.
 - You will need stabilizer (Ultra Clean & Tear), two layers per hooping.
 - Backing fabric - you will need 1 yard to which we will be adding buttonholes and buttons so that you can switch out your pillow.
 - You will need batting, 14" x 45"
 - If you want piping, you will need to bring fabric and 3 yards of cotton cording.
- Decorative threads that will go best with your fabrics and some metallics to give it a little pop. You will also need thread for the construction and the quilting of the pillow. Please do not forget your embroidery bobbin case and your regular bobbin case. You can preload the embroidery bobbin case/bobbin with bobbin thread, and the regular bobbin case/bobbin with the thread that you will use for piecing.

Before coming to class:

- Be sure to load your designs.
