**Class Policies:**

- Classes must be paid for at time of registration. One week cancellation notice required for refund or credit fees. For blocks of the month, the upcoming session must be paid for BEFORE the date of the session.
- It is important to have all your materials before class begins and to have your sewing machine set up and ready to sew. Our teachers make every effort to start on time.
- All brands of sewing machines and sergers are welcome.
- As a courtesy to others, please turn off cell phones during class. If you must take a call, please step out of the classroom to limit disruption to the class.
- Small, basic, non-embroidery machines are available for \$10.00 rental fee at time of registration.
- This class is for the specific project as described here. If you wish to make something different, it should be done outside of class.
- **PLEASE** do not use perfumes, colognes, scented hair products, or lotions prior to class, so that those with allergies or asthma may enjoy the class as well.

**Supplies you will need:**

- Embroidery/sewing machine in good working order with power cord, foot control, slide on tray and a new needle. Embroidery hoop for your machine of appropriate size, and the hoop template for your hoop. Be sure to bring your sewing machine instruction book if you are sewing on something other than a BERNINA.
- **Basic Sewing Supplies**
  - Good quality fabric scissors
  - Small scissors or snips
  - Seam ripper
  - Straight pins
  - Fabric marker
  - Extra machine needles
  - Pen & paper for notes
  - Anything else you commonly use for a day of sewing!
- Rotary cutter, ruler and mat.
- **Jingle All the Way** machine embroidery pattern from Kimberbell. Please purchase from the store in time to do class preparation. You will need to load the embroidery design onto a stick or directly into

your machine. I used the 6" x 10" size but you will need to load the largest you can use with your hoops. Please be sure to check it and make sure that your machine is reading it. Please do not forget to bring your book.

- Feet – You will need your favorite ¼" foot (i.e. #97/97D), your favorite embroidery foot, a walking foot for the second class, and your open toed appliqué foot (#20/20D).
- Fabric requirements –
  - You will need 10 2½" strips the width of the fabric and please choose several different prints and patterns.
  - You will need two background pieces that are 9" x 14" or larger for the embroidery.
  - You will need two layers of stabilizer (Ultra Clean & Tear) twice for the hoop you will be embroidering in.
  - Backing fabric - you will need 1 yard and piece it or purchase 2 yards if you do not want a seam in the back.
  - You will need batting 14" x 72"
  - If you want another fabric for the binding then you will need to purchase accordingly.
- Decorative threads that will go best with your fabrics and some metallics to give it a little pop. You will also need thread for the construction and the quilting of the table runner. Please do not forget your embroidery bobbin case and your regular bobbin case. You can preload both the bobbin case with bobbin thread, and the sewing bobbin case with the thread that you are using to piece. Please bring an extra bobbin to the second class that is loaded with the thread that you are going to use for quilting.

### **Before coming to class:**

- Be sure to load your designs.
