Class Policies:

- Classes must be paid for at time of registration. One week cancellation notice required for refund or credit fees.
- It is important to have all your materials before class begins and to have your sewing machine set up and ready to sew. Our teachers make every effort to start on time.
- All brands of sewing machines and sergers are welcome.
- As a courtesy to others, please turn off cell phones during class. If you must take a call, please step out of the classroom to limit disruption to the class.
- Loaner machines are available for \$10.00 rental fee at time of registration.
- This class is for the specific project as described here. If you wish to make something different, it should be done outside of class.
- **PLEASE** do not use perfumes, colognes, scented hair products, or lotions prior to class, so that those with allergies or asthma may enjoy the class as well.

Supplies you will need:

- Sewing machine/ Embroidery Sewing machine combo. in good working order with power cord, foot control, slide on tray and a new needle. Be sure to bring your sewing machine instruction book if you are sewing on something other than a BERNINA. You will need all your hoops and templates for your machine.
- **Basic Sewing Supplies**
 - Good quality fabric scissors
 - Small scissors or snips
 - Seam ripper
 - Straight pins
 - Fabric marker
 - Extra machine needles
 - Pen & paper for notes
 - Anything else you commonly use for a day of sewing!
- Rotary cutter, ruler and mat. You are going to want to have a square-up ruler that is at least 8 ½", along with a regular ruler that is at least 14 – 16" minimum in length.

- Book – **“Kimberbell Cuties”**. If you want to do the appliqués in your embroidery module then you will need to purchase the design pack – **“Kimberbell Cuties Companion CD”** that goes with the book.
- Threads for both construction and the decorative thread for the appliqués. This will depend on your fabric choices.
- Fabric – If you have lots of scraps dig them out and let’s start to make a dent in them. To make 2 placemats you will need the following. If you wish to make more you will need to adjust the fabric accordingly.
 - You will need 1 strip that is 9” x WOF for the background of the umbrellas
 - You will need 4 charm squares for the umbrellas,
 - You will need 2 pieces of fabric for the flange (“crumb catcher”) that are 1” x WOF”
 - For the checkerboard you will need 2 pieces of fabric that are 2” x 22”
 - For outer border, you will need 4 pieces of fabric that are 2 ½” x WOF
 - If you want separate binding you will need approx 120 inches of binding.
 - Backing fabric 2 pieces of fabric that are 16” x 20”.
 - 2 pieces of batting the same size.
- Feet:
 - Favorite embroidery foot (mine is #15)
 - Favorite ¼” foot
 - Walking foot with all soles
 - If you are not using a module for embroidery you will need to bring an open toed appliqué foot.

Before coming to class:

- If you are NOT using your module you will need to trace 4 umbrella patterns onto the paper side of fusible web and 20 rain drops from page 27 (be sure to trace the wooden handle). Do not cut this out or fuse it to any fabric. Just trace them and bring them to class.
