



Get Sewing with Pre-Cuts - Basket of Charms

Class Policies:

- Classes must be paid for at time of registration. One week cancellation notice required for refund or credit fees. For blocks of the month, the upcoming session must be paid for BEFORE the date of the session.
- It is important to have all your materials before class begins and to have your sewing machine set up and ready to sew. Our teachers make every effort to start on time.
- All brands of sewing machines and sergers are welcome.
- As a courtesy to others, please turn off cell phones during class. If you must take a call, please step out of the classroom to limit disruption to the class.
- Small, basic, non-embroidery machines are available for \$10.00 rental fee at time of registration.
- This class is for the specific project as described here. If you wish to make something different, it should be done outside of class.
- PLEASE do not use perfumes, colognes, scented hair products, or lotions prior to class, so that those with allergies or asthma may enjoy the class as well.

Supplies you will need:

- Sewing machine in good working order with power cord, foot control, slide on tray and a new needle. Be sure to bring your sewing machine instruction book if you are sewing on something other than a BERNINA.
- **Basic Sewing Supplies**
 - Good quality fabric scissors
 - Small scissors or snips
 - Seam ripper
 - Straight pins
 - Fabric marker
 - Extra machine needles
 - Pen & paper for notes
 - Anything else you commonly use for a day of sewing!
- Rotary cutter, ruler and cutting mat
- **Basket of Charms** pattern by Sweet Jane's Quilting
- Fabric:
 - Packet of 40+ 2 ½ x 2 ½ squares (a **free** packet of 42 Toscana Microchips fabric squares like used in the class samples will be

included in your registration for this class.) This is enough squares to make the large or medium basket. You will have enough leftover squares to make the small basket.

- For either the large or medium basket: two fat quarters plus ½ yard fusible interfacing.
 - For interfacing, the large and small shop samples were made with Bosal In-R-Form foam for the outer layer and light weight woven fusible for the lining. The medium size sample was made with Pellon 808 Craft Fuse fusible interfacing.
- Helpful to have:
 - walking foot, dual feed on your machine and/or Bernina #10 foot
 - small iron and ironing pad for your sewing table

Before coming to class:

- Read over the pattern instructions and the instructions for any fusible interfacing you plan to use.
- Clean and oil your machine.
- Double check the accuracy of your ¼" seam with the foot you will be using!
