Class Policies:

- Classes must be paid for at time of registration. One week cancellation notice required for refund or credit fees. For blocks of the month, the upcoming session must be paid for BEFORE the date of the session.
- It is important to have all your materials before class begins and to have your sewing machine set up and ready to sew. Our teachers make every effort to start on time.
- All brands of sewing machines and sergers are welcome.
- As a courtesy to others, please turn off cell phones during class. If you must take a call, please step out of the classroom to limit disruption to the class.
- Loaner machines are available for \$10.00 rental fee at time of registration.
- This class is for the specific project as described here. If you wish to make something different, it should be done outside of class.
- PLEASE do not use perfumes, colognes, scented hair products, or lotions prior to class, so that those with allergies or asthma may enjoy the class as well.

Supplies you will need:

- Embroidery machine in good working order with power cord, foot control, and a new needle. Be sure to bring your embroidery machine instruction book if you are sewing on something other than a BERNINA.
- **Basic Sewing Supplies**
 - Good quality fabric scissors
 - Small scissors or snips
 - Seam ripper
 - Straight pins
 - Fabric marker
 - Extra machine needles
 - Pen & paper for notes
 - Anything else you commonly use for a day of sewing!
- The design pack titled **Starry Night Santa**. You need to purchase it from Embroidery Design Studio,
<https://www.embdesignstudio.com/products/designs/brand/oese/Starry-Night-Santa/> Download it to your USB device in the proper format for your machine. You can access the studio from any Quilt 'N Sew

Connection newsletter. Be sure you only download one format as it is very hard to keep the designs straight if you download more than one format.

- Your large oval hoop, and/or Midi hoop. If you have more than one large oval hoop you will want to bring it because you can be hooping while the other is sewing.
- Fabric –
 - Background – You will need 3 1/3 yards
 - We will discuss borders, backing, binding and batting during class.
- Threads: Isacord #0015, 0020, 0138, 0532, 0555, 0576, 0622, 0776, 0853, 0933, 0970, 1133, 1141, 1233, 1346, 1362, 1521, 1725, 2022, 2336, 2776, 3574, 3743, 3951, 3953, 4071, 5552, 5555, 5743, 6071.
- You will need several filled bobbins and a bobbin that has COLORED thread on it. This does not have to be bobbin thread.
- Ultra Clean 'n' Tear stabilizer. I recommend purchasing 2 - 20" rolls because you will need three thicknesses per block. Please do not cut this ahead of time because the stabilizer needs to be bigger than the fabric square
- Extra size 80/12 Universal needles.
- Please bring your oil (if you have a Bernina) as we will need to oil before the day is out.

Before coming to class:

- Please cut 2 strips background fabric, 9" in height by width of fabric. Starch both sides and roll onto your stabilizer roll so that it does not get wrinkled.
- We will be breaking for lunch so plan accordingly
- Load your designs to your stick and print all pages of the instructions as you will need to see the designs and the thread charts for each block.
