Class Policies:

- Classes must be paid for at time of registration. One week cancellation notice required for refund or credit fees. For blocks of the month, the upcoming session must be paid for BEFORE the date of the session.
- It is important to have all your materials before class begins and to have your sewing machine set up and ready to sew. Our teachers make every effort to start on time.
- All brands of sewing machines and sergers are welcome.
- As a courtesy to others, please turn off cell phones during class. If you must take a call, please step out of the classroom to limit disruption to the class.
- Small, basic, non-embroidery machines available for \$10.00 rental fee at time of registration.
- This class is for the specific project as described here. If you wish to make something different, it should be done outside of class.
- **PLEASE** do not use perfumes, colognes, scented hair products, or lotions prior to class, so that those with allergies or asthma may enjoy the class as well.

Supplies you will need:

- Embroidery machine in good working order with power cord, foot control, slide on tray and a new needle. Embroidery hoop for your machine of appropriate size, and the hoop template for your hoop. Be sure to bring your sewing machine instruction book if you are sewing on something other than a BERNINA.
- **Basic Sewing Supplies**
 - Good quality fabric scissors
 - Small scissors or snips
 - Seam ripper
 - Straight pins
 - Fabric marker
 - Extra machine needles
 - Pen & paper for notes
 - Anything else you commonly use for a day of sewing!
- Rotary cutter, ruler and mat.
- **"Twilight Boo-levard"** machine embroidery pattern from Kimberbell. Please purchase from the store in time to do preparation for class.

You will need to load the embroidery designs into your machine or to a stick prior to coming to class, as well as print instructions

- Fabric requirements as listed on the CD when you print out the instructions. If you are not ordering the Embellishment kit then you will want to include some Fairy Frost in orange, black and purple.
- Polymesh that has been pre washed and dried. You will need enough for 14 hoopings in your large oval or Midi hoop (5½" x 9")
- Decorative threads that will go best with your fabrics and some metallics to give it a little pop. Please do not forget your bobbin thread and at least one bobbin that has a dark color of thread on it for a few of the designs.
- Glue stick (Elmers School glue works best)
- Your favorite curved scissors for cutting around the appliqués.
- You will need your hoop template, for whichever hoop you will use.

Before coming to class:

- Be sure to load your designs and you might consider your fabric choices.
- We will be discussing the embellishments and other items.
- You will need to pre-cut your 7 backgrounds and then starch them twice before coming to class.
- If you have a bench pillow please bring it and if you do not we will discuss how to make one.
- You will need to print the entire instructions that are found on the CD.
