

TROPIC TOWN ORDINANCE NO. #2020-4

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TROPIC TOWN BUSINESS LICENCE ORINANCE #2018-7
IN THE TOWN OF TROPIC, GARFIELD COUNTY UTAH

WHEREAS, as the Mayor and Town Council of Tropic Town, Garfield County, State of Utah, believe it is in the best interest of the citizens and community of Tropic Town to enact reasonable requirements to “Business Licensing”; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL OF TROPIC TOWN, GARFIELD COUNTY, STATE OF UTAH, AS FOLLOWS:

A. The Town of Tropic, Utah Business Licensing Definitions is hereby amended and defined as follows:

- (1) “Business” means and includes all activities engaged in within this municipality carried on for the purpose of gain or economic profit, except farming and ranching operations. Whole sale operations are also excluded if no place of business is maintained I the Town.
- (2) “Temporary License” means any license issued for a period of 45 calendar days or less. Persons operating temporary businesses must have a temporary license at the location of their business.

The rest and remainder of Definitions is hereby ratified, reaffirmed and shall remain in full force and effect.

B. Business License Fees amended to read:

“Exception to the Business License Fees

- (1) No license fee shall be imposed to any person engaged in business for solely religious, charitable eleemosynary or other types of strictly non-profit purpose, which is tax exempt in such activities under the laws of the United States and the State of Utah.
- (2) Any business or person exempted by state and federal law.

C. Business License Application amended to read:

It shall be a class B misdemeanor for any person to transact, engage or carry on any business, trade, profession, etc. without first receiving the class or type of license required by the town. Each day of operation without a business license shall be a separate offense, with a penalty of \$25.00 per day. If a business license has not been approved by the Town by February 1st of the current year, any penalties shall relate back to January 1st of the current year. A lien will be recorded on the business’ real property for any outstanding penalties.

Business License Application, Item (d) & (e) amended to read:

- d. Provide sales tax license numbers acquired from the Utah State Tax Commission: Sales Tax, Restaurant Tax, and/or Transient Room Tax.
- e. Provide twelve-(12) month Utah Sales Tax payment confirmation for applicable sales payment amounts.

The rest and remainder of the Tropic Town Business License Application and items (g), (h), & (i) is hereby ratified, reaffirmed, and shall remain in full force and effect.

D. Denial, Revocation or Suspension Item (c) amended to read:

- c. Unwillingness to remit applicable sale truces; TC62S (Sales Tax), TC62F (Restaurant tax), and/or TC-62R (Transient Room Tax).

The rest and remainder Denial, Revocation, or Suspension and items (d), (e), (f), & (g) is hereby ratified, reaffirmed, and shall remain in full force and effect.

The rest and remainder of the Tropic Town Business License Ordinance #2018-7 is hereby ratified, reaffirmed, and shall remain in full force and effect.

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage.
