

**TOWN OF TROPIC TOWN, UTAH
PROPER WASTE DISPOSAL Ordinance
NO. 2019-2**

AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE THE DISPOSAL OF SOLID WASTE AND OTHER OBJECTS IN THE LARGE DUMPSTERS PLACED THROUGHOUT THE TOWN OF TROPIC.

WHEREAS, Tropic Town provides Solid Waste Collection and Disposal services;

WHEREAS, Tropic Town operations are negatively impacted by waste generators not closing the lids on dumpsters, dumping large objects in the Right-of Ways and in front of the dumpsters in a manner that the garbage truck operator cannot access the dumpster, and placing unsuitable materials in the dumpsters;

WHEREAS, solid waste generators operating outside the Town limits are using the Town waste facilities and unauthorized use of the Town dumpsters causes an unfair burden on the residents of Tropic Town;

WHEREAS, large appliances and other metal objects can be disposed in the dumpster at the Tropic Town Maintenance Yard during regular business hours.

WHEREAS, Tropic Town has developed a tree limb and grass clipping disposal area; and

WHEREAS, proper disposal of solid waste materials would be advantageous to the Town; and

WHEREAS, Tropic Town wants to establish a system where individuals performing certain waste disposal operations are held accountable for misuse of the Town's solid waste disposal services;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Town of Tropic as follows:

1. Individuals and businesses using the solid waste dumpsters throughout the Town of Tropic shall close the lid on the dumpsters after each proper disposal of solid waste.
2. It is a violation of this Ordinance to place solid waste objects in the Town Right-of-Ways and outside of the garbage dumpsters.
3. It is a violation of this Ordinance to place solid waste generated outside of Tropic Town in any Town waste collection device.
4. It is a violation of this Ordinance to place improper waste items i.e. dead animals, hazardous materials, tree limbs, construction materials and large appliances in any Town waste collection device meant for ordinary solid waste.
5. Violation of provisions 1 – 4 of this Ordinance are subject to a fine of \$250.00.
6. Effective Date – This Ordinance shall become effective upon passing.
